

Reflection on the Readings

Green Team Scripture Reflections

In the face of mounting disasters, conflict, and changing weather, it's easy for many of us to lose hope and motivation to speak up for climate action, instead conceding to the apathy, doubt, and unease our warming planet causes. Climate anxiety affects many, but Isaiah 35 proclaims directly to our fear that God is here with us! "Be strong, fear not! Here is your God, he comes with vindication... Streams will burst forth in the desert, and rivers in the steppe. The burning sands will become pools, and the thirsty ground, springs of water."

If we allow ourselves to lean into our faith, we will be able to open our eyes, hear the cries of the earth, and sing our demands for climate action with strength, courage, and passion. Yet we must be discerning in our movement forward and, as James 2 shares, "show no partiality as you adhere to the faith". May our plans not be evil in design like James warns us, ensuring that we continue to hear the cries of the poor and not just hear those who are rich or those with power, our modern-day men "dressed in fine clothes and gold rings."

May the Lord open our mouths as he did for the man in Mark 7, so that we may speak up for our shared Earth and communities!




