

Rejoice, all Beasts of thickets and of rocks.




### Happy Earth Day!

For the first 28 days of Lent, **46 parishioners of St. Ignatius parish saved 3887kg of carbon equivalents from entering the atmosphere.** Our sacrifices are made for the love of God and neighbor.

# The Saintly Six: Postcard Campaign to Petition the Vatican







The St. Ignatius Racial Justice Committee (RJC) is assisting St. Katharine Drexel Parish in Dorchester with a postcard campaign to advocate for the canonization of six African American Catholics.

Known as the "Saintly Six," Fr. Augustus Tolton, Mr. Pierre Toussaint, Mother Mary Lange, Mother Henriette DeLille, Ms. Julia Greeley, and Sr. Thea Bowman were inspirational Black Catholic leaders and lifelong advocates for racial and social justice.

After each liturgy next weekend, **April 26/27**, members of the RJC will be stationed in the gathering space with information about the candidates and the campaign. We ask that parishioners sign stamped postcards and we will forward them to Pope Francis. We are grateful for your support of our efforts to recognize these holy models of faith and courage.




